Program Proposal

The University of Pécs is pleased to offer a summer school program for the students' of its partner universities.

**Date:** 19 July - 2 August, 2026

**Title of the program:** International Financial Law, Compliance and Regulatory Practice

**Number of participants:** min. 15 students

### Short description

This summer school is designed for law students who wish to gain a solid understanding of international financial law, regulatory frameworks and compliance practices in an increasingly interconnected global environment. The programme offers a comparative and practice-oriented perspective on financial integrity, risk management and regulatory standards, with a particular focus on international and European legal frameworks.

Through topics such as comparative financial regulation, forensic accounting, and international compliance mechanisms, participants will gain insight into how legal systems address complex financial and economic challenges at both global and regional levels. Special attention is given to the protection of public financial interests within the European Union and the functioning of EU-level institutions from a legal perspective.

The programme also explores the impact of technological innovation on financial regulation, including developments related to blockchain, cryptocurrencies and digital financial systems, highlighting their legal implications and regulatory responses.

Taught by leading academics and practitioners, the summer school provides participants with up-to-date legal knowledge, practical insights and internationally relevant skills, preparing them for further studies and careers in financial law, compliance, regulation and related legal fields.

### Eligible students:

Law students (BA, MA, PhD levels); Criminology students (BA, MA, PhD levels); Police Sciences students (BA, MA, PhD levels)

**Earned credits:** 6 ECTS credits

Students will also receive a certificate for completing the program.



### Language requirements:

Minimum English language requirements: Independent user (B2 according to Common European Framework of Reference of Languages)

Can understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in their field of specialization.

Can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without strain for either party.

Can produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

## Program Fee

**Program fee: 1,950 EUR**

**The program fee includes the following:**

**1. Educational Program:**

The program fee covers all costs related to the classes, given by the University of Pécs lecturers (2x45-minute-long classes each).

**2. Meal:**

Students and the lecturer will be provided with lunch on the teaching days. When evening programs are organized, dinner is also included (Welcome dinner, Quiz Night with dinner, Farewell dinner, etc.). This proposal includes regular meals. Any special diet needs an extra charge.

**3. Transport:**

We will be pleased to arrange 1 airport shuttle for the group from Budapest Liszt Ferenc Airport to Pécs on 19 July, Sunday and 1 private bus to Budapest on 1 August, Saturday.

Students will also be provided with local bus tickets and guidance about how to use local transport in Pécs.

**4. Accommodation:**

We will provide accommodation in a dormitory of the University of Pécs. Students will be staying in double rooms.

**5. Non-educational programs, excursions**

We are pleased to organize the following excursion for the students:

- 1-day tour to Budapest

The program fee includes the following services during the Budapest trip:



The University of Pécs offers a genuinely international learning environment. The university has been running degree programs in English for 40 years and is now one of the most internationalised universities in Hungary. We are proud to welcome over 5,500 international students each year – students from more than 140 countries worldwide. The university manages over 100 degree programs and preparatory courses for international students taught in English and German. Additionally, the University of Pécs actively participates in various mobility programs and has received the European Union's Erasmus Quality Award twice for its achievements. Besides full-degree international programs, the university organizes numerous summer schools, short-term programs and winter programs for incoming international students.



The University of Pécs is one of the largest research universities in Hungary. The University functions as a knowledge centre for innovation in the South Transdanubian Region. Nearly 2,000 members of our teaching and research staff at our 10 schools participate in research projects, whilst 22 doctoral schools offer PhD and DLA degrees covering a wide spectrum of knowledge.





## Pécs

Pécs is located in the southern part of Hungary, close to the Croatian border. It is the 5th largest city in the country. The closest airport is in Budapest, which is a 2.5-hour drive from Pécs.



Located in the Southwestern part of Hungary, Pécs is a culturally diverse and stimulating city, with a population of about 150,000. It is one of the most beautiful Central European cities. Lying in the South of Transdanubia, close to the border with Croatia, it has a mild, almost Mediterranean climate.

The history of Pécs dates back over 2,000 years, and the name of the old Roman town, "Sopianae", is still found in the names of institutions and products.



Although its development suffered several setbacks throughout the centuries, such as during the Tartar invasions or the Ottoman-Turkish Rule, it has not only survived, but developed into a pleasant, modern town, rich in historical monuments, an administrative, cultural, and educational centre with a lot to offer to those who wish to live or study here. The town is famous for its museums, galleries, festivals and cultural events it hosts. It is a 'City of Culture'.

The downtown of Pécs is a unique mixture of the relics of Early Christianity, the arrival of the Hungarians, the Turkish reign and the achievements of modern architecture and art. The National Theatre, the Philharmonic Orchestra, the internationally renowned Ballet Ensemble, as well as the unique Zsolnay Cultural Quarter, offer fascinating experiences.
