ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The University of Regina (U of R) has campuses located in Regina and Saskatoon, on Treaty 4 and Treaty 6 territories. These are the ancestral lands of the nêhiyawak (nay-hi-yuh-wuk, Cree), Anihšīnāpēk (uh-nish-i-naa-payk, Saulteaux), Dakota, Lakota, Nakoda, and the homeland of the Métis/Michif Nation.

As a comprehensive university, the U of R traces its roots back to Regina College, a small residential high school established by the Methodist church in 1911. The College grew in size and significance becoming a campus of the University of Saskatchewan and, ultimately, an independent degree granting university – the University of Regina – in 1974.

VISA INFORMATION

Please note that exchange students do not need a study permit to study at the University of Regina while on exchange. All students staying for **longer than 6 months** require a Study Permit. Language of Instruction

English

Language Certificate

Exchange students do not have to submit proof of English Language Proficiency. It is the students' responsibility that they are comfortable with learning in a complete English environment.

All lectures are taught in English.

It is highly recommended that one of these ELP test scores is met:

TOEFL: Internet based (83); Reading (20); Listening (20); Speaking (20); Writing (20).

IELTS: Overall Band score of 6.5, with no band less than 6.0.

Duolingo online English Test: Overall Score of 120; Literacy (105); Comprehension (105); Conversation (105), Production (90).

CREDITS AND COURSES

Standard Credit Load for a Semester

Must be enrolled as full-time students while on exchange (3 – 5 classes). We generally recommend students take 3 or 4 classes as 5 classes is considered very demanding.

Registration for Courses

Students' transcripts and course requests are evaluated by the Academic Advisors at the University of Regina to ensure that students have the academic background necessary for the classes that they select. Students will be instructed on how to create a visual schedule builder upon receiving their acceptance letter, and Faculty academic advisors will register students into classes.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Students **must have** international health insurance coverage. It must cover them for the entire duration of their stay in Canada. It is up to the student's discretion to choose a provider that works best for them and their needs.

ACCOMMODATION

The University of Regina has a wide variety of comfortable, modern housing options available for exchange students.

It is the responsibility of the incoming student to arrange their own housing, whether it be on-campus or otherwise.

Off-Campus Accommodation	Arrangement of off-campus accommodation must be arranged by the student. The University of Regina cannot assist with this type of housing.
